5. Portfolio

The content of the portfolio is determined by your field of study.

Your application should give a clear impression of your work. Ensure images are of good quality.

Indicate your name on each item. Check that, DVDs or CD-roms function properly, both on Mac and PC.

Digital slides:

- Preferably by mail, but if the document is too large on cd-rom (3 copies), label disc and case with your name
- In a power point presentation
- Maximum 15 images

Videos on DVD:

- If possible by e-mail
- Indicate on both the DVD and its case your name, the title and duration of each piece, sound/no sound, and whether the piece is reproduced in whole or in part.
- Compilations should be made of pieces longer than 10 minutes

Audio and/or Video Recordings:

- Publicly available recordings or private recordings on CD or DVD
- Copies and (maybe) reviews of concert programmes

NB Original work is not accepted during the first selection round.

Don't send in any pictures bigger than 500 Kb, books, publications or catalogues.

In case you are invited for an interview, you may bring work with you.
