

**Application form for a Scholarship for "NEW " non-EEA students 2010-2011**

**and**

**for non-EEA students who started their studies in September 2008 or September 2009 and who did not apply for a non-EEA scholarship for 2008-2009 or 2009-2010.**

If you are a student from a country not belonging to the European Economic Area (a so-called non-EEA student) except Surinam or Switzerland, who applies for the first time for one of our Bachelor or Master programmes and who has insufficient financial means, you may apply for a Scholarship.

If you currently are a non-EEA student who started the study in 2008-2009 or 2009-2010 and you did not apply for a non-EEA scholarship for this study years 2008-2009 or 2009-2010, you can also apply for a non-EEA scholarship 2010-2011.

A Scholarship amounts to a maximum of € 1.800,- for a full-time study and € 1.300,- for a part-time study. The number of Scholarships is limited. The maximum number of scholarships is four times (being for 4 study years).

With the awarding of this financial concession to a maximum of 125 new "non-EEA students", the tariff for study fees is:

€ 2.200,- for a full-time and

€ 1.700,- for a part-time course.

In all other cases the tariffs are € 4.000,- and € 3.000,- respectively.

You have to apply well before the start of the academic year, at the latest before the 1<sup>st</sup> of July 2010. The aim is to award the Scholarships before the 1<sup>st</sup> of August 2010.

The scholarship will be awarded conditionally, i.e. will be paid after your official enrolment.
